Dress Rehearsal 12/11:

A reminder that we do have a dress rehearsal for the "Southside Christmas Spectacular" today immediately after school until 4:30 pm with the entire Fine Arts Department. Students do NOT need to wear their concert attire; this is simply what we call the final run-through rehearsal. This is VERY important – please do not miss this.

Concert Attire / Santa Hats:

Everyone has received their concert attire now. Be sure to have it properly altered prior to the concert. Also, all students will wear a plain, red Santa hat for this performance. Don't wait until the last minute to find one. Below are guidelines for proper concert attire:

Ladies: Concert black dress. Black panty hose must be worn, closed toed black dress shoe with not too large of a heel, appropriate under garments that do not show, no wrist jewelry, simple earrings only. Pear necklaces are provided and collected back from the band.

Ladies: Full tuxedo set (coat, trousers, tux shirt, bowtie, vest, black dress shoes). Long, black socks with appropriate dress shoes must be worn, plain white undershirt (no graphic tees – they will show through) (do not go without an undershirt....we will see too much under stage lights) no wrist jewelry.

Every year the band is Etowah County's biggest donator of toys for Toys for Tots. Normally, this is our admission to the concert; however, this year as it is not only the band we are merely asking for donations.
