## Important Information

**Monday Rehearsals:** Due to the early nature of our first two games/performance and the interval from our previous rehearsal, we will have full-ensemble Monday rehearsals for the next two weeks. However, this is not always successful – bottom line, to achieve a truly uniformed look, everyone's pants must fit correctly. 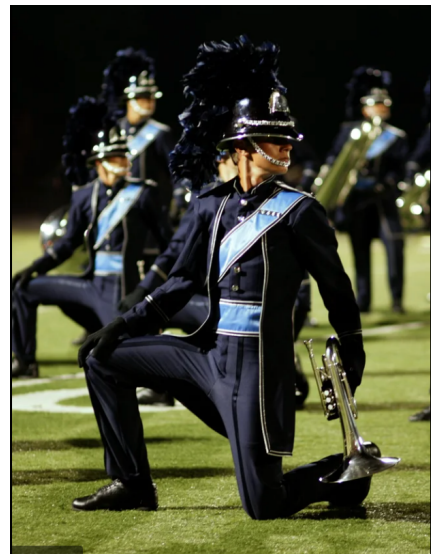
## How Bibbers Should Fit



Notice the “break” of the pants is right at the top of the shoe. This is higher than most people think at first.

It is CRITICLE that the shoulder straps be properly adjusted so that the seat of the pants is as close to the skin as is possible without being uncomfortable **BEFORE** the leg is hemmed.

If the inseam is too low, then the pants will split in the seat when students go into a lunge.

### From the Directors:

- Students are to use the restrooms prior to the game. Should they need to use the facilities, chaperones will escort groups.
- Students are to remain in their positions in the assigned seating area for the entirety of the game. The PRIDE is there to do a job, supporting our school through all four quarters of the game. \*We will not eat in uniform during the game. The PMA Boosters will feed every student after home games, and Christ Central Methodist has agreed to feed the band before all away games.
- Non band members are not allowed in the band seating area.
- Have fun! Be professional.

# Game Day Procedures

1. **REPORT TIME:** Report or call-time is when everyone is needed to be in place and ready to go; **not just arriving**. Be sure to double check that you have all items of required equipment and uniforms including PMA-issued water jugs.
2. **UNIFORM CODE / INSPECTIONS:** All students are required to be in uniform throughout the entire game day. We all do the same thing, the same way at the same time. All members will be inspected before we leave the band room to make sure they are in compliance with our Uniform Code. This code can be found online handbook. Students out of uniform will not be allowed to perform.

### Highlights:

- Nails must be a natural color
  - Hair must be out of one's face and not touch the collar of one's coat
  - No unnatural hair color is allowed in uniform
  - When not being worn, the coat is to be folded uniformly and placed on top the shako
  - Auxiliary members' hair and makeup will match and conform to the guidelines assigned by their instructors and the directors
3. **BUS PROCEDURES:** Under Federal mandate, ECBOE policy mandates assigned seating and for masks to be worn at all times while on the bus.
  4. **STADIUM PROCEDURES:** All members are required to sit together in the band section throughout the entire game. Non-band members (including parents/boyfriends/girlfriends) are not allowed in the band section. \*\*Students going to the bathroom **must** be accompanied by a chaperone. (This is for their safety) Bathrooms are on an emergency basis only. Food is not allowed in uniform during the game.
  5. **CHECKOUTS** (Away Games Only): Once the game is over, students will load equipment and the bus to come home. Parents wishing to checkout their child after the game (away games only) should email a permission note to the band office no later than Thursday of that week. Students must load their equipment and make arrangements for their uniform with their section leader. **Parents must sign-out their child in the stadium with the PMA VP for Chaperones. Students are only allowed to checkout with a parent or legal guardian.**
  6. **DISMISSAL:** Students are dismissed **as a group** from the school on Friday nights. Once all of our equipment is stored and checked, and uniforms are hung properly then students will be dismissed. Students are not allowed to leave as soon as we get back to the high school. The faster we get everything put away, the faster we all go home. 😊
