Important Information

Annual Bedsheet Sale: Our annual bedsheet sale will begin Thursday and last through the 29th. All orders and money are due Friday, October 30th. This sale always does well for us because the products are amazing! Profits earned from this fundraiser go towards helping students to pay their membership fees. We're asking every member to sell at least two sets of sheets to help the band program meet our fundraising goal of at least \$3,000. More would be even better! Info will be sent home on Thursday.

Concert Attire: Now is the time to begin placing orders for concert attire with Tuxedo Inn of Gadsden. Orders and money are due to them by November 7. Dresses are \$75 (excludes alterations), pants, coat, tie, tuxedo shirt, and vest together are \$150. This is our standard concert uniform and does not change from year to year. All payments will be made directly to Tuxedo Inn of Gadsden. They require a \$45 deposit to place the order and the remaining balance upon receipt.

Fall Concert Oct. 29: Our Fall Concert has been moved to Thursday, October 29th at 6 pm. The event will be held at Barney Hood Stadium. Students are encouraged to dress up in costume for this family-fun event which will feature performances by the Symphonic Band, Percussion Ensemble, and The PRIDE of Southside Marching Band. There is no admission, but donations are appreciated. Concessions will be sold.
