We are beyond thrilled to announce that after a three-year hiatus due to COVID, the annual Etowah County Marching Band EXPO is back!! Understandably, many of you will not know what this event is, so I wanted to take a moment and explain it to you.

What Is It?

The EXPO is a showcase performance of the high school bands in Etowah County in all of its school systems. It is a fundraiser for all of the bands and serves as a practice “run-through” before competitions begin at the end of September. Basically, it’s a pre-Mid-South event very similar to our Pre-MPA Concert every February. A panel of guest judges will make comments and offer suggestions for improvement as we prepare for contests such as Mid-South & Covered Bridge.

Where & When?

The EXPO will be held Tuesday, September 13, 2022, in GCHS’s Titan Stadium (1917 Black Creek Parkway). The EXPO will begin at 6:30 pm with the national anthem performed by the combined bands featuring over 600 students! Admission is \$5 (cash or card), concessions are available, and parking is free!

Our Itinerary

A full itinerary will be published soon, but this will operate much like a football game. There will be a call time to meet in the band room. We will bus to GCHS, warm up, perform the anthem, sit in the stands as a group to watch the other bands, perform our show, and then depart for home. We will not do checkouts for this show so that we can get everyone home sooner on a school night. *
