Info for 8th-Grade Marchers

- 1. Membership Fees: While you have been selected to perform with the high school band, you are still members of Rainbow Middle School and thus, your financial obligations are to that school. This means that 8th grade marchers do not pay the \$300 HS membership fee, but rather pay their normal band fee to RMS. However; you are responsible for purchasing resale items such bibbers & shoes. **Any 8th grader using a HS owned marching instrument (percussion, sousaphones, etc.) should pay the \$50 instrument rental fee to Southside High School.
- **2. Bibbers & Shoes:** While the band provides the coat and shako (hat), individual members purchase and keep their own bibbers (pants) and marching shoes. These items will be purchased online and delivered to your house once we are able to meet in person and size everyone. Hopefully, this will be at our July 16th Pre-Camp meeting.
- **3. Marching Videos & Music:** Unfortunately, we weren't able to have rookie camp this year and teach everyone how to march; however, we do have a great recourse on our website from the University of Alabama's Million Dollar Band. These three videos contain the basics that we use through our halftime show. Additionally, you can also download and practice our pregame show, and traditional music.
