More Information:

1. **Security** – Uniformed officers will be present to patrol Titan Stadium and the campus of GCHS. First Aid will be provided by the Etowah County Rescue Squad and will be located inside the field house.
2. **Video Recordings** – ProCat Audio/Video will be on site to professionally record performances. DVD's will be available the day of.
3. **Band Seating** – A seating chart will be included in each Director's information packet upon arrival. Due to the large number of bands participating, please adhere to this strictly and pack them in a close together as possible.
4. **Equipment Loading** – GCHS Band does offer help transporting your larger pieces of equipment from the warm-up area to the performance area. Mid-South will not be held responsible for any damage to the contents of the equipment trailer. Please have a parent available to supervise the loading/unloading and transport of your equipment. The loading area is adjacent to the warm-up area. ***We welcome any band to bring their own transportation system for their equipment. This will eliminate wait times and expedite the loading and unloading process.***
