Driving Directions

- GPS 140 Newt Parker Drive, Boaz, AL 35957
- All Boaz High School entrances will be closed
- Spectator Parking will be behind the BHS Field House and can be accessed by Darnell Street or Newt Parker Drive
- Overflow Spectator Parking will be in front of Boaz High School and can be accessed by Brown Street
- Bus Parking will be at Boaz Middle School and can be accessed by Darnell Street or Newt Parker Drive
- Equipment Truck Parking will be in the side parking lot of BMS and can be accessed by Darnell Street or Newt Parker Drive

Band Classification

Classification is based on the number of winds and percussion (including front ensemble/pit). Order of performance will be based upon the total number of performers. Bands may enter a higher classification, but not a lower one. The number of winds and percussion (including front ensemble/pit) will be counted during the performance. Any band exceeding the classification number will receive a penalty to their total band score.

A- up to 40 AA- 41-65 AAA- 66-90 AAAA- 91-120 AAAAA- 121- up

Awards

Trophies will be awarded for Superior Ratings, and Best in Class awards will be presented to the highest rated unit in each caption for each classification containing two or more bands. Auxiliary units will receive a rating regardless of size but must have at least three (3) members in order to be eligible for Best-in-Class awards.

- Please have a parent available to supervise the loading/unloading and transport of your equipment.
- We welcome any band to bring their own light transportation system for their equipment. (This will eliminate wait times and expedite the loading and unloading process.)

- There should be NOTHING left on the field after your performance.

Stadium Seating & Policy


- There will be a seating diagram in your registration packet
