## <u>Update on The PRIDE's Christmas Performances</u>

First, we want to congratulate everyone on a very successful football season and a terrific Fall Concert! Thank you to everyone who came out to support the band, and a huge thank you to our PMA Boosters and local sponsors.

We want to update everyone on our Christmas plans as things this year look a bit different from normal. Firstly, the Gadsden Christmas Parade was canceled, and with it, our after-school parade rehearsals. Our regular "Southside Christmas Spectacular" program will not be possible in the auditorium, and as the weather can be quite unpredictable this time of year, we have decided not to hold this event as usual.

Instead, we are pleased to announce that we have two new and unique performances for the Christmas-season for a total of three after-school commitments. The Symphonic Band will perform at the Southside City Tree Lighting Ceremony on Tuesday, December 8th, and we are excited to announce our first ever Carol-Grams performances that will occur on December 10th and 15th. ## **Christmas Carol-Grams**

**Info:** Since we can't bring the community to our concert, we're going to take the concert to the community! The PRIDE is selling Christmas Carol-Grams this year. For \$25, members of the band will travel via bus to houses to perform a mini-concert of five Christmas Carols in their front lawns on either December 10<sup>th</sup> or 15th (\*students will not come into contact with occupants).
